RESEARCH ELIGIBILITY TEST: RET-2021
For Admission to Ph.D. Programme

ELIGIBILITY:-

Postgraduate degree in the relevant subject with minimum 55% marks from a recognized University. A relaxation of 5% marks at the PG level will be given to SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer) / MBC (Non-creamy layer)/EWS and Differently-Abled students. Students appearing in P.G. final year/ last semester of the current session may also apply, their admission will be subjected to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria at the time of interview.

RESERVATION:

During allotment of Supervisors, vacancies in each subject will be filled as per reservation norms of Government of Rajasthan. If candidates from reserved categories are not available, vacancies may be filled by General candidates as per the UGC rules.

FEE STRUCTURE:

Fees will be same for all categories Rs. 2000/-. (Payment will be made online through e-mitra/ ICICI payment gateway system only)

SCHEME OF TEST:

The examination will consist of two papers conducted in a single session of three hours. Paper I consisting of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) (Two mark of each question) and Paper II consisting of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) (Two mark of each question). There will be no negative marking.

PAPER-I (Duration 1 hours)

The syllabus of the research methodology is as under-

Unit-I

Research- Concept of Research, Objectives, Types of Research, Research Report

Unit- II

Research Methodology, Research Process, Selection of Research Problem, Concept of Hypothesis, Hypothesis Testing, Techniques of Hypothesis Testing.

Unit-III

Research Design, Sampling Method, Type of Sample, Probability Sampling, Non-Probability Sampling

Unit-IV

Data Collection, Types of Data, Methods & Techniques of Data collection:

Interpretation of Data, Statistical tools & techniques, Measures of tendencies -Mean, Median, Mode.

Unit-V

Ethics Issues in Research, Code of Ethics in Research, Importance of Ethics in Research

PAPER — II (Duration 2 hours)

This paper will be separate for each subject and will consist of 100 MCQ. There will be no negative marking. The syllabus for this paper will be the same as that of UGC /CSIR NET examination.

Paper — II will be evaluated only for those candidates who are able to secure the minimum qualifying marks in Paper-I as per the table given below:
